

List of Supporting Documents, Which May Be Needed

As Proof Of Income For Legal Aid Assessment

Based on the information that you provide us with, we **may** need you to send in any of the following documents to help us work out whether you are eligible to claim Legal Aid:-

- Property valuation if you own your own home (this can be an online valuation via Zoopla)
- Most recent Mortgage statement
- Rent agreement, tenancy agreement or letter from landlord/parents/friend
- Housing benefit letter if you are in receipt of housing benefit
- Up to date Wage slips (1 x monthly or 4 x weekly)
- Bank statements (for all current and savings accounts) for last four weeks
- Valuations & statements of any capital assets (boats, caravans, prestige car, shares, bonds or investments)
- Original Letter from DWP (all four pages) or letter stating still in receipt of benefit, which benefit you are in receipt of & whether it is income or contribution based, if appropriate
- Tax Credit Award letter
- Child Benefit letter
- Pension details
- Statements of Dividends or Trusts
- Statement of Child Care Costs if over £600 per month

If you are self- employed, we will require the following:-

- Last four weeks Bank statements for all business, current & savings accounts
- Most up to date accounts
- Cash book
- Most up to date End Of Year Income Tax Assessment
- Up to date Tax Deduction Certificates if a sub-contractor
